## FOR FURTHER THOUGHT:

- 1. What physical traits did you get from your father? Did you get any of his temperament or tendencies? What's the best thing your father passed on to you?
- 2. Read Matthew 1:18-19. Note the following detail:
  - A. "betrothed" = pledged to be married
  - B. "before they came together" = before the actual marriage
  - C. "divorce her quietly" = the 3 options open to Joseph were
    - i. Stoning
    - ii. Public divorce to end betrothal
    - iii. Quiet divorce before 2 or 3 witnesses
  - D. What does Joseph's choice of option 3 tell you about his character?
- 3. When did God tell Joseph what was happening with Mary (Mt 1:20-21)? Why do you think He didn't tell him sooner?
- 4. We saw last week that Mary went to visit Elizabeth right after Gabriel told her she would bear the Messiah (Luke 1:39), and that she stayed 3 months before returning to Nazareth (Luke 1:56). Since Joseph hadn't yet been told by God what is happening, how might you imagine Joseph responding to Mary's explanation of her pregnancy?
- 5. What is Joseph's response to the dream (v24)? What does that tell you about his character?
- 6. Matthew tells us that Joseph had no union with her until after Jesus was born. Why would he include that detail?
- 7. Which of Joseph's traits do you see as most important in a father? Why?
- 8. Are there traits in Joseph that you would like to characterize you more? As you pray for one another, zero in on those traits.
